- Sports Academy Programming (Hockey):

 Two 1-hour ice sessions each week from September March
 - On Ice sessions will include technical skill development, specialty coaches and tactical concepts
 - Small area skill development to enhance players skills and game understanding
 - April June: additional excursions that compliment hockey specific dryland training and additional athletic activities (i.e., wall climbing)
 - Cost Estimated @ \$1350.00/school year. The fee would be \$135.00/month for 10 school months
 - Cost will include student transportation

This letter needs to be submitted no later than 20 days from submitting the registration form. Failure to submit a reference letter for new students can void the registration.
- ❖ A non-refundable deposit of \$270 must be paid when the registration form is submitted.
- * REFUNDS will be processed according to full months of non-enrollment only, subject to withholding of the non-refundable deposit of \$270.
- ❖ Greater St. Albert Sports Academy student registrations will be accepted on a first come first served basis. You are encouraged to get your registration in as soon as possible, as space may be limited by school capacity.
